STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

The Parking Places (Amendment) Order, 1980

Made the 19th day of May, 1980.

Coming into force on the 27th day of May, 1980.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section one of the Road Traffic (Parking Places) Ordinance, 1963(a), hereby orders:-

1. The Parking Places Order, 1968, as amended (b), is hereby further amended as follows:-

- (a) in sub-paragraph (i) of paragraph (a) of section six thereof the word, letters and figures "A7 or A49" are repealed and the word, letters and figures "A7, A49, A55, A56, A57 or A58" are substituted therefor;
- (b) in paragraph 3 of section eight thereof the word, letters and figures "A7 or A49" are repealed and the word, letters and figures "A7, A49, A55, A56, A57 or A58" are substituted therefor;
- (c) in paragraph (b) of section nine thereof the word, letters and figures "D92 and D97" are repealed and the word, letters and figures "D92, D97 and D112" are substituted therefor;
- (d) in paragraph (g) of section nine thereof the word, letters and figures "D102 and D105" are repealed and the word, letters and figures "D102, D105, D113 and D114" are substituted therefor;
- (e) the entries relating to disc parking place No. D48 in each of the columns of Part I of the First Schedule thereto are repealed and the entries in each of the columns of the First Schedule to this Order are substituted therefor;
- (f) immediately after the entries relating to disc parking place No. D111 in each of the columns of Part I of the First Schedule thereto there are inserted respectively the entries in each of the columns of the Second Schedule to this Order;

(g) immediately after the entries relating to approved parking place No. A54 in each of the columns of Part II of the First Schedule thereto there are inserted respectively the entries in each of the columns of the Third Schedule to this Order.

2. This Order may be cited as the Parking Places (Amendment) Order, 1980.

3. This Order shall come into force on the twenty-seventh day of May, nineteen hundred and eighty.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Section one (e)

"D48 Les Croutes,
St. Peter Port. The west side of the road between a parking sign placed as near as may be to the entrance to Saint Stephen's Church and a parking sign placed as near as may be to its junction with Saint Stephen's Lane."

SECOND SCHEDULE

Section one (f)

"D112 Mansell Court,
Saint Peter Port. The east side of the road between a parking sign placed as near as may be to the entry to the private lane which links Mansell Court with Mansell Street and a parking sign placed as near as may be to the southern end of Mansell Court.

D113 Stanley Road,
Saint Peter Port. The south side of the road between a parking sign placed as near as may be to the entry to the unnamed lane at the eastern end of the road and a parking sign placed as near as may be to the "no waiting" line at the western end of the road.

D114	Valnord Road, Saint Peter Port.	The north and east sides of the road between a parking sign placed opposite the junction with Valnord Hill and a parking sign placed as near as may be to the premises known as No. 3 Rozel Terrace."

THIRD SCHEDULE

Section one (g)

"A55	Smith Street, Saint Peter Port.	The portion of the north side of the road between the southern extremity of disc parking place No. D4 and the junction with Forest Lane indicated by a parking sign as being reserved for a public vehicle standing or plying for hire.
A56	North Esplanade, Saint Peter Port.	The portion of the road to the south of the States Office car park indicated by a parking sign as being reserved for a public vehicle standing or plying for hire.
A57	The Quay, Saint Peter Port.	The portion of the west side of the road adjacent to the premises of the Midland Bank and Croasey's Ltd., indicated by a parking sign as being reserved for a public vehicle standing or plying for hire.
A58	South Esplanade, Saint Peter Port.	The west side of the road alongside the premises known as "Harbour House" where indicated by a parking sign as being reserved for a public vehicle standing or plying for hire."
