The Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets)(No. 2)(Repeal)
Regulations 1981

Made the 16th day of April, 1981

Coming into operation on the 24th day of April, 1981

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article X of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine (a), and the Ordinance entitled "The Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950" (b), and of all powers enabling it in that behalf hereby makes the following Regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in this Island:-

1. The Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets) Regulations, 1981 (c), are hereby repealed. ✓

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets)(No. 2)(Repeal) Regulations, 1981.

3. These Regulations shall come into force on the twenty-fourth day of April, nineteen hundred and eighty-one.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note forms no part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport).

The effect of these Regulations is to restore a two-way traffic system in that portion of Le Rocher Road, Saint Martin, which lies between the eastern entry to Blanchelande College and its junction with Les Aubrets.
