

GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

1988 No. 11

The Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets) Regulations, 1988

Made: 6th June 1988.

Coming into operation: 10th June 1988.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article X of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of 2nd March, 1929 (a), and the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950 (b), and of all powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating vehicular traffic in this Island:-

1. A person being in charge of a vehicle exceeding two tons laden weight shall not, without the permission in writing of the Chief Officer, drive that vehicle on or along that portion (otherwise known as Bouillon Lane) of the Rue des Courtillets, Saint Andrew's, which lies between its junction with Bouillon Road and the entrance to Le Bouillon Farm.

2. In these Regulations -


"Chief Officer" means the Chief Officer of the Island Police Force;

"vehicle" has the meaning assigned to it by Article I of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of 2nd March, 1929.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets) Regulations, 1988.

4. These Regulations shall come into force on the 10th day of June, 1988 and shall continue in force until the 5th day of December, 1988.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note forms no part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport)

Under the provisions of section 5B of the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1970, as amended, vehicles exceeding five tons laden weight are not permitted to travel along the narrow portion of the Rue des Courtillets, St Andrew's, which lies between its junction with Bouillon Road and the entrance to Le Bouillon Farm. The effect of these Regulations is that from 10th June, 1988 until 5th December, 1988, vehicles exceeding two tons laden weight will not be permitted to travel along this portion of road.
