THE WRECK AND SALVAGE (RESTRICTED AREAS) ORDER 1997 GUERNSEY

MADE: 1 APRIL 1997

COMING INTO OPERATION: 1 APRIL 1997

The States Heritage Committee, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Section 18 of the Wreck and Salvage (Vessels and Aircraft) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1986, being of the opinion that the site identified in article 1 of this order is or may prove to be the site of a vessel, cargo, or other object on or in the sea bed and that because of the historical, archaeological or artistic importance of the vessel, cargo or object the site ought to be protected from unauthorised interference, hereby orders:-

1. The site in position latitude 49.26.08, longitude 02.31.48 marked on a chart which, for the purposes of identification, was signed by the President of the Committee on even date herewith, and a copy of which had been lodged at the Greffe for public inspection, is hereby designated for the purposes of the said section 18.
2. The following shall be in a restricted area for the purposes of the said section 18:-
 - (a) any area on the sea-bed within a circle the radius of which is 50 metres and the centre of which is the site identified in article 1,
 - (b) any area in or upon the sea lying immediately above the said circle.
3. The site identified in article 1 shall be known as the Lead Ingot Wreck.
4. This order shall come into force on the first day of April 1997.

Explanatory Note


This order designates a restricted area round the Lead Ingot Wreck within which diving operations are prohibited (unless authorised by licence of the Committee).
