Amendment No 2 to the Open General Import Licence

Made	2nd March, 2001
Coming into force	2nd March, 2001

The Policy & Finance Committee in exercise of the powers under Section 2 and 3 of the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Alderney) Order, 1995 hereby amends the Open General Import Licence dated the 26 January 2001, as follows:—

1. In schedule 2:-

- a) delete entry number 2010 and replace with the following-
“feedstuffs intended to be fed to ruminants which contain protein material derived from ruminants imported from the United Kingdom and the Republic of Ireland”
- b) add entry number 2017 as follows-
“fertilisers containing meat or bone meal imported from the United Kingdom and the Republic of Ireland”
- c) add entry number 2018 as follows-
“The carcass of an animal including any products made or processed therefrom and imported from the United Kingdom and the Republic of Ireland or sourced therefrom, except
 - a] a carcass of any animal or any products made or processed therefrom prior to the 1 February 2001;
 - b] the carcass of, or any product made or processed from

- poultry;
- c] fully cooked meats or products containing fully cooked meats;
 - d] tinned meats;
 - e] pre-cooked meals; and
 - f] exotic meats, i.e. ostrich, kangaroo and alligator”
- d) add entry number 2019 as follows-
“Hay, straw and litter imported from the United Kingdom and the Republic of Ireland”
- e) add entry number 2020 as follows-
“Milk and dairy products imported from the United Kingdom and the Republic of Ireland except for milk which has been pasteurised at a temperature of at least 71.7 °C for 15 seconds or to milk products made from milk pasteurised according to the specifications set out above”

This Licence shall come into force on 2 day of March 2001.
