THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER 2000

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in pursuance of its powers under Article 1 of the Import and Export (Control)(Guernsey) Law 1946, hereby orders: -

- 1 The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order 1990, (a), as amended (b) shall be amended as follows: -


Section 6 shall be deleted and replaced by the following: -

6 (1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this Section, no goods shall be unshipped, landed or put on shore, or shipped, put off or waterborne to be shipped for exportation, except at or (as the case may be) from the Harbours of Saint Peter Port or Saint Sampson or La Villiaze Airport.

(2) Electrical energy may be imported or exported by means of the submarine cable which enters the Island at Havelet Bay in the parish of St Peter Port.

2. This Order may be cited as The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) (Amendment) Order 2000, and shall come into force on the 31st May 2000.
