The Milk (Retail Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1992

THE STATES AGRICULTURAL AND MILK MARKETING BOARD, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Resolution of the States dated 28th January, 1987 made under section 3 of the Milk and Milk Products (Guernsey) Law of 1955, as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, hereby orders:-

1. The price to be charged on a sale by retail of milk shall be as follows:-

During the period commencing on the fifth day of July, nineteen hundred and ninety-two and ending on the fourth day of July, nineteen hundred and ninety-three, at the rates of 79p per litre, and 41p per half-litre for full cream and low fat milk; 40p per half-litre for skimmed milk; Provided that the provisions of this paragraph shall not apply to any milk supplied to a beneficiary under any scheme for the time being in force provided by the States for the supply of milk whether free of cost or at a reduced price.

2. The Milk (Retail Prices) (No. 2) (Guernsey) Order 1991 is hereby revoked.

3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

4. This Order may be cited as the Milk (Retail Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1992 and shall come into force on the fifth day of July, nineteen hundred and ninety-two.
