**THE PROHIBITED AND ONE-WAY STREETS (AMENDMENT)(NO.1) ORDER,

THE STATES TRAFFIC COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 3A(1) of the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, as amended (a), hereby orders:-

Amendment to 1989 Ordinance.

1. In Paragraph 16 of Part I of Schedule 1 to the Prohibited and One-Way Streets Ordinance, 1989, as amended, the words "Le Tourgand" are deleted, and the words "La Plaiderie" are inserted in their place.

Citation.

2. This Order may be cited as the Prohibited and One-Way Streets (Amendment) (No. 1) Order, 1998.

Commencement.

3. This Order shall come into force on 1st June 1998.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note does not form part of the Order)

The purpose of this Order is to make permanent the experiment which removed the requirement for a permit for access through Le Pollet as far as La Plaiderie. This was introduced on 1st June 1997.
