GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

The Social Insurance (Classification) (Amendment) Regulations, 1999

Made 11th March, 1999

Laid before the States

Coming into operation 2nd April, 1999

THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 1(4) of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended^a, hereby orders:-

Amendment

1. In the First Schedule to the Social Insurance (Classification) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended^b

- (a) in column A of paragraph 6, the words “of a married woman by her husband” are deleted and replaced by “of any person by his spouse”;
- (b) in column A of paragraph 14 the word “wife” is replaced by “spouse”;
- (c) in column A of paragraph 15 the words “married woman” are replaced by “spouse” and “her husband” is replaced by “his spouse”;
- (d) in column B of paragraph 15
 - (i) for the erroneous reference to paragraph 19 there is substituted “14”; and
 - (ii) for the word “she” there is substituted “he”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations amend the classification, for Social Insurance purposes, of husbands and wives working for each other in order to treat both spouses alike.
