GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

**The Health Service (Medical Appliances) (Amendment)
Regulations, 1999**

Made 17 March, 1999.
Laid before the States 1999.
Coming into Operation 1 April, 1999.

THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 15 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990^(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment

1. For the First Schedule of the Health Service (Medical Appliances) Regulations, 1990, as amended^(b) substitute the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

Citation

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Medical Appliances) (Amendment) Regulations, 1999.

Commencement

3. These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1st day of April, 1999.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These Regulations further amend the Health Service (Medical Appliances) Regulations, 1990, as amended, to include giving sets for enteral feed in the list of medical appliance available under the Health Service Benefit Guernsey Law and other minor amendments.
