The Merchant Shipping (Tonnage) (Amendment) (Guernsey)
Regulations, 1980

Made 3rd June 1980

Coming into operation 9th June 1980

THE STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section one of the Merchant Shipping Act, 1965, (a) as extended to the Bailiwick of Guernsey by the Merchant Shipping Act 1965 (Guernsey) Order, 1969, (b) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

1. The Merchant Shipping (Tonnage) (Amendment No.2) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1975, (c) shall be amended as follows:-
 - (a) for Regulation 2 there shall be substituted the following:-
 - "2. The measurement and survey of a ship for the purpose of ascertaining its tonnage may be undertaken by a surveyor appointed by an authorised Classification Society instead of by a surveyor of ships." ;
 - (b) in Regulation 3, in paragraphs (b) and (c), for "Lloyd's Register of Shipping" there shall be substituted "an authorised Classification Society" ;
 - (c) in Regulation 6, paragraph (1)(a), for "Lloyd's Register of Shipping" there shall be substituted "an authorised Classification Society" ;
 - (d) in Regulation 8, paragraph (1), before the definition of "the Principal Act" there shall be inserted the following definition:-

"authorised Classification Society" means Lloyd's Register of Shipping, the British Committee of Bureau Veritas, the British Technical Committee of the American Bureau of Shipping, the British Committee of Det norske Veritas and the British Committee of Germanischer Lloyd (being organisations authorised for the measurement and survey of ships by the States Board of Administration) ;".
2. These Regulations may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Tonnage) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1980, and shall come into operation on 9th June 1980.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not a part of the Regulations)

The Merchant Shipping (Tonnage) (Amendment No.2) (Guernsey) Regulations 1975 provide for the measurement and survey of certain ships for the purpose of ascertaining their tonnage to be undertaken by Lloyd's Register of Shipping, as well as by the Department of Trade.

These Regulations amend the 1975 Regulations so as to enable the measurement and survey of any ship for this purpose to be undertaken by Lloyd's Register of Shipping and by four other authorised Classification Societies, namely the British Committee of Bureau Veritas, Det norske Veritas and Germanischer Lloyd, and the British Technical Committee of the American Bureau of Shipping.
