The Public Health (Notifiable Diseases) Order, 1974

Made 3rd May, 1974

Laid before the States, 1974

Coming into operation 13th May, 1974

THE STATES BOARD OF HEALTH, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section one of Article VI of the Public Health Ordinance, 1936, as amended^(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

1. The following infectious or contagious diseases, that is to say:-

brucellosis; and

psittacosis;

are hereby declared to be notifiable diseases within the meaning of section one of Article VI of the Public Health Ordinance, 1936, as amended.

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948^(b), shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

3. This Order may be cited as the Public Health (Notifiable Diseases) Order, 1974.

4. This Order shall come into force on the thirteenth day of May, nineteen hundred and seventy-four.
