The Social Insurance (Benefits) (Transitional Provisions) (Amendment)
(Guernsey) Regulations, 1979

Made 19th June, 1979

Laid before the States

Coming into operation 25th June, 1979

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Part II of the Fourth Schedule to the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of regulation eleven of the principal regulations

1. In regulation eleven of the Social Insurance (Benefits) (Transitional Provisions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, immediately after paragraph (2) thereof, there is hereby inserted the following paragraph:-

"(3) Where it appears that a woman would have satisfied the relevant contribution conditions under the Law of 1964 in relation to maternity allowance in respect of any period of fifty-two weeks ending on or before the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-nine, had that Law not been repealed, then, if a direction is made under this paragraph by or on behalf of the Authority, she shall be entitled to maternity allowance under the Law in all respects as if such number of reckonable contributions of the appropriate class or their equivalent as shall be specified in that direction had been paid by, or credited to, her in respect of that period."

Citation and collective title

2. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Benefits) (Transitional Provisions) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1979.

(2) These regulations may be cited together as the Social Insurance (Benefits) (Transitional Provisions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978 and 1979.

Commencement

3. These regulations shall come into force on the twenty-fifth day of June , nineteen hundred and seventy-nine.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport)

These regulations amend the Social Insurance (Benefits) (Transitional Provisions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, so as to empower the Authority to direct that a woman shall be entitled to maternity allowance notwithstanding that the relevant contribution conditions are not satisfied in any case where she would have been entitled to such allowance under the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1964, but for the repeal of that Law by the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978 (regulation one).
