

The Animal Products Importation Order, 1984

Made 18th July, 1984

Laid before the States

Coming into Operation ... 23rd July, 1984

THE STATES COMMITTEE FOR AGRICULTURE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 10 of the Animals and Animal Products (Import and Export) Ordinance, 1952, as amended (a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders -

1. The importation of boneless beef and veal, excluding offal, into the Island from the undermentioned countries shall be permitted, provided that such meat shall have first been landed in the United Kingdom or the Republic of Ireland:

Austria	Italy
Belgium	Luxembourg
Czechoslovakia	Poland
Denmark	Romania
France	Switzerland
Holland	West Germany
Hungary	Yugoslavia

2. The importation of boneless beef, excluding offal, into the Island from Botswana, Swaziland or the Republic of South Africa shall be permitted, provided that such meat shall have first been landed in the United Kingdom or the Republic of Ireland.
3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 (b), shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. The Animal Products Importation Order, 1977 (c), is hereby repealed.
5. This Order may be cited as the Animal Products Importation Order, 1984.
6. This Order shall come into force on the twenty-third day of July, 1984.
