THE STATES ADVISORY AND FINANCE COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Article 36 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948(a) as amended(b), hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Specified sum for candidates' copies of Electoral Roll

1. It is hereby specified that the sum which must be paid to Her Majesty's Greffier by a candidate at an election to procure additional copies of the Electoral Roll (or of the section thereof concerning any Electoral District) is the sum of five pence for each page in the Electoral Roll (or in that section of it).



2. These Regulations may be cited as the Electoral Roll (Specified Sum for Candidates' Copies) Regulations, 1993.

Commencement

3. These Regulations shall come into operation on 1st August, 1993.

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

An election candidate is entitled to one free copy of the Electoral Roll section for the district in which he is standing (the entire Roll in the case of a Conseillers' election) and up to four additional copies on payment to H. M. Greffier of a sum specified by Regulations. These Regulations set the specified sum at five pence per page.
