The Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets)
Regulations, 1983

Made the 10th day of June, 1983.

Coming into operation on the 17th day of June, 1983.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article X of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine (a), and the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950 (b), and of all powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating traffic in this Island:

1. A person, being in charge of a vehicle or an animal shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer, drive or ride that vehicle or cause or permit that vehicle or animal to proceed on or along -

- (a) Courtil Simon Lane, Castel, otherwise than from north-east to south-west;
- (b) the road forming a loop through the Clairval States Housing Estate, Collings Road, Saint Peter Port, otherwise than from east to west;
- (c) the access road through the Valnord States Housing Estate, Saint Peter Port, otherwise than from west to east.

2. (1) In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings respectively assigned to them:-

"animal" and "vehicle" have the meanings assigned to them by Article I of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Véhiculaire en cette Ile" of the second day of March, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine;

"Chief Officer" means the Chief Officer of the Island Police Force.

(2) Except where the context otherwise requires, any reference in these Regulations to any other enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed and replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment including these Regulations.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets) Regulations, 1983.

4. These Regulations shall come into force on the tenth day of June, nineteen hundred and eighty-three and shall continue in force until the ninth day of December, nineteen hundred and eighty-three.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note forms no part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport)

The effect of these Regulations is that for a period of six months from the 10th June, 1983 -

- (a) Courtil Simon Lane, Castel, will be a one-way street, traffic being required to proceed from the direction of Le Villocq Estate towards its junction with the Route de Cobo;
- (b) Clairval States Housing Estate Road, Collings Road, Saint Peter Port, will be a one-way street, traffic being required to proceed from the direction of its junction with Collings Road nearest to Fosse Andre towards its junction with Collings Road nearest to Valnord Lane;
- (c) Valnord States Housing Estate Road, Saint Peter Port, will be a one-way street, traffic being required to proceed from the direction of its junction with Valnord Lane towards its junction with the Clairval Housing Estate Road.
