The Milk (Retail Prices) (Guernsey) Order 1980

THE STATES DAIRY COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by subsection (1) of section eight of the Milk (Control) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1958, as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, hereby orders:-

1. The price to be charged on a sale by retail of milk, whether or not produced in this Island, shall be as follows:-

(i) During the period commencing on the first day of July, nineteen hundred and eighty, and ending on the thirtieth day of September, nineteen hundred and eighty, at the rate of 21p per pint;

(ii) During the period commencing on the first day of October, nineteen hundred and eighty, and ending on the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and eighty, at the rate of 22p per pint;

(iii) During the period commencing on the first day of December, nineteen hundred and eighty, and ending on the thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and eighty-one, at the rate of 23p per pint:

Provided that the provisions of this paragraph shall not apply to any milk supplied to a beneficiary under any scheme for the time being in force provided by the States for the supply of milk whether free of cost or at a reduced price.

2. The Milk (Retail Prices) (Guernsey) Order 1979 is hereby revoked.

3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

4. This Order may be cited as the Milk (Retail Prices) (Guernsey) Order, 1980 and shall come into force on the first day of July, nineteen hundred and eighty.
