THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section sixty-nine of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended (a) and in exercise of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendments to the Regulations of 1978

1. In paragraph (1) of Regulation 1 of the Social Insurance (Benefits) (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended (b), (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations") the definition of the expression "free in-patient treatment" is hereby repealed.
2. Regulations 28, 29, 30, 31 and 32 of the principal Regulations are hereby repealed.

Repeal

3. The Social Insurance (Increase of Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1979(c) are hereby repealed.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Benefits) (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1985.



EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations repeal the definition of the expression "free in-patient treatment" in Regulation 1(1) of the principal Regulations and Regulations 28, 29, 30, 31 and 32 of the principal Regulations and has the effect of removing the adjustment which was applied to certain benefits where the beneficiary or a dependant of the beneficiary was an in-patient in the Castel Hospital.
