**The Health Service (Medical Appliances) (Amendment)
Regulations, 1997**

Made	29 May, 1997.

THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 15, 16, 18 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990(a) and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment

1. In Regulation 7 of the Health Service (Medical Appliances) Regulations, 1990, as amended(b) for "section 12 of the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 1976(c)" substitute:-

"Section 14 of the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 1997(d)"

Citation

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Medical Appliances) (Amendment) Regulations, 1997.

Commencement

3. These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1st day of June, 1997.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These Regulations further amend the Health Service (Medical Appliances) Regulations, 1990, as amended, to provide that the cross-reference in Regulation 7 now refers to the Misuse of Drugs Ordinance (Bailiwick of Guernsey), 1997, rather than a different section in the 1976 Ordinance, which has now been repealed.
