**The Health Service (Pharmaceutical)
(Payment of Approved Suppliers)
(Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations,
1990**

Made 15th August, 1990.
Laid before the States 26th September, 1990.
Coming into operation 1st September, 1990.

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 12 and 23 of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Guernsey) Law, 1972, as amended^(a), hereby orders:—

Amendment to the Regulations of 1983

1. The Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1983, as amended^(b), are hereby further amended as follows:—

- (a) the First Schedule thereto is repealed and the Schedule set out in the First Schedule to these regulations is substituted therefor;

- (b) the Second Schedule thereto is repealed and the Schedule set out in the Second Schedule to these Regulations is substituted therefor;
- (c) the Third Schedule thereto is repealed and the Schedule set out in the Third Schedule to these Regulations is substituted therefor.

Supplemental payment to approved suppliers

2. An approved supplier shall be paid out of the Guernsey Health Service Fund in respect of each item of pharmaceutical benefit—

- (a) which was supplied by him under the said Law of 1972 during the period commencing on the 1st day of March, 1989, and ending on the 28th day of February 1990; and
- (b) in respect of which payment has been made out of that Fund upon the receipt by the Authority of a certificate relating to any part of that period and issued by the body appointed by the Authority to calculate the sum payable to approved suppliers in respect of pharmaceutical benefit supplied by them under the said Law;

in addition to that payment, a sum equal to—

- (a) 4.6208 per centum of the amount paid in respect of that item under regulation 2 of the said Regulations of 1983, when the approved supplier is a pharmacist; or
- (b) 3.9287 per centum of the amount paid in respect of that item under the said regulation 2, where the approved supplier is a medical practitioner.

Extent

3. These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

Citation

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1990.

Collective Title

5. These Regulations and the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1983 to 1989, may be cited together as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1983 to 1990.

Commencement

6. These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1st day of September, 1990.

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EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport)

These Regulations further amend the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1983 (as amended), so as to provide for an adjustment to the payments due in respect of the supply of pharmaceutical benefit by different classes of approved suppliers.
