GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT 1981 NO. 16

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (AMENDMENT) (GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1981

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION in pursuance of its powers under Article 1 of the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Law, 1946 hereby orders:-

1. At the end of the First Schedule to the Import and Export (Control) (Guernsey) Order, 1978 (a) there shall be inserted the following entry:-

"Wireless telegraphy apparatus consisting of radio telephonic apparatus capable of transmitting on any frequency between 26.1 and 29.7 megacycles per second or between 88 and 108 megacycles per second and notwithstanding that the said apparatus is also capable of transmitting on other frequencies outside the said limits."

2. This Order may be cited as The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Order, 1981, and shall come into force on the twenty-second day of July, nineteen hundred and eighty-one.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Amendment Order but is intended to indicate its general purport).

The effect of this Amendment Order is to prohibit the importation of certain wireless telegraphy apparatus consigned from the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey or the Isle of Man except under the authority of an Individual Import Licence.
