THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL) (GUERNSEY) ORDER 1978

AMENDMENT NO.2 TO THE OPEN GENERAL IMPORT LICENCE OF 1982

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in exercise of its powers under section 3 of the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Guernsey) Order 1978(a) hereby modifies the Open General Import Licence granted by the said Board upon the 16 February 1982(b) as follows:-

1. Article 5 shall be deleted and the following Article 5 shall be substituted therefor:-

"5. Nothing in this Licence shall authorise the importation of any goods listed in Schedule 4 hereto or of any goods which have been exported from Argentina or from the Falkland Islands and Dependencies (S. Georgia and S. Sandwich Group)".

2. Amendment No.1 to the Open General Import Licence of 1982(c) is hereby revoked.

3. This amendment shall come into operation on the seventeenth day of May, nineteen hundred and eighty-two.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the amendment to the Open General Import Licence but is intended to indicate its general purport).

The effect of this Amendment is to prohibit the importation of any goods which have been exported from the Falkland Islands and Dependencies (S. Georgia and S. Sandwich Group) as well as Argentina, consigned from a place outside the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey or the Isle of Man, except under the authority of an Individual Import Licence.
