THE PREVENTION OF TERRORISM (TEMPORARY PROVISIONS) ACT
1976 (AMENDMENT) (GUERNSEY) ORDER 1979

Made 26th July, 1979


Whereas, under section 1(3) of the Prevention of
Terrorism (Temporary Provisions) Act 1976 as extended
to the Bailiwick by the Prevention of Terrorism (Temporary
Provisions) Act 1976 (Guernsey) Order 1976, the States
Emergency Council may by order add to Schedule 1 of that
Act as so extended any organisation that appears to it
to be concerned in terrorism occurring in the United
Kingdom or Guernsey and connected with Northern Irish
affairs, or in promoting or encouraging it:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon
it by section 1(3) of the said Act of 1976 as so extended,
THE STATES EMERGENCY COUNCIL, hereby make the following
Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Prevention of Terrorism
(Temporary Provisions) Act 1976 (Amendment) (Guernsey)
Order 1979 and shall come into operation on the 27th
day of July, nineteen hundred and seventy-nine.
2. The following organisation, that is to say -
"Irish National Liberation Army"
is hereby added to Schedule 1 of the Prevention of
Terrorism (Temporary Provisions) Act 1976 as extended
to the Bailiwick by the Prevention of Terrorism
(Temporary Provisions) Act 1976 (Guernsey) Order

1976 (which specifies organisations which are proscribed organisations for the purposes of that Act as so extended).
