

**The Terrorism and Crime (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law
2002 (Proscribed Organisations) (Amendment No. 2)
Regulations 2003**

THE STATES ADVISORY AND FINANCE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by section 3(3) of the Terrorism and Crime (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2002^a, hereby orders:-

Proscribed Organisations

1. The following organisations are hereby added to Schedule 1 to the Terrorism and Crime (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2002:-

Abu Sayyaf Group

Asbat Al-Ansar

Islamic Movement of Uzbekistan

Jemaah Islamiyah.

Amendment to note to Schedule 1 of the Law

2. Schedule 1 to the Terrorism and Crime (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2002 shall be amended by adding at the end of the note to the Schedule the words:-

^a Order in Council No. XVI of 2002.

“The entry for Jemaah Islamiyah refers to the organisation using that name that is based in South East Asia, members of which were arrested by the Singapore authorities in December 2001 in connection with a plot to attack US and other western targets in Singapore”.

Revocation of Regulations

3. The Terrorism and Crime (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2002 (Proscribed Organisations) (Amendment) Regulations, 2003 are hereby revoked.

Citation and Commencement

4. These regulations may be cited as the Terrorism and Crime (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law 2002 (Proscribed Organisations) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations, 2003 and shall come into force on 13th May 2003.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations add the organisations mentioned in Regulation 1 to the list of proscribed organisations in Schedule 1 to the Terrorism and Crime (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 2002. Regulation 2 adds a note to Schedule 1 providing that the fourth organisation listed is the organisation of that name based in South East Asia, members of which were arrested by the Singapore authorities in December 2001 in connection with a plot to attack US and other western targets in Singapore. The amendments mirror those made to the Terrorism Act 2000 by the Terrorism Act 2000 (Proscribed Organisations) (Amendment) Order 2002. Finally the Regulations revoke the Terrorism and Crime (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law 2002 (Proscribed Organisations) (Amendment) Regulations, 2003.
