

GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

The Wireless Telegraphy Apparatus (Restriction) Order, 1996

**THE STATES TELECOMMUNICATIONS BOARD**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 1 of the Wireless Telegraphy Apparatus (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1994(a), hereby makes the following order:-

Prohibition of possession, etc. of certain apparatus.

1. (1) The States Telecommunications Board, for the purpose of preventing or reducing the risk of interference with wireless telegraphy, hereby imposes the following restrictions in relation to wireless telegraphy apparatus specified in this Order (being certain descriptions of cordless telephone apparatus and Citizens' Band apparatus).

(2) No person shall, in the Bailiwick of Guernsey, in relation to any description of wireless telegraphy apparatus, take any action specified in subsection (3) if that action is for the time being restricted in the United Kingdom in relation to that description of wireless telegraphy apparatus under the Wireless Telegraphy (Citizens' Band and Amateur Apparatus) (Various Provisions) Order 1988(b), the Wireless Telegraphy (Cordless Telephone Apparatus) (Restriction) Order 1987(c) or any other order for the time being in force under section 7 of the Wireless Telegraphy Act 1967(d).

- (3) The actions referred to in subsection (2) are-
- (a) manufacture (whether or not for sale);
  - (b) selling or offering for sale, letting on hire or offering to let on hire or indicating (whether by display of the apparatus or by any form of advertisement) one's willingness to sell or let on hire;
  - (c) possession; and
  - (d) importation.

**Marking of CB apparatus.**

2. (1) Wireless telegraphy apparatus of any description required, in the United Kingdom, to be marked under the Wireless Telegraphy (Citizens' Band and Amateur Apparatus) (Various Provisions) Order 1988 shall, in the Bailiwick of Guernsey, be marked in accordance with the requirements specified in relation to that description of wireless telegraphy apparatus in Schedule 2 to that Order(e).

(2) No person shall, in the Bailiwick of Guernsey, in the course of any trade or business, supply or offer to supply wireless telegraphy apparatus which does not comply with subsection (1).

**Marking of cordless telephone apparatus.**

3. (1) Wireless telegraphy apparatus of any description required, in the United Kingdom, to be marked under the Wireless Telegraphy (Cordless Telephone Apparatus) (Restriction) Order 1987 shall, in the Bailiwick of Guernsey, be marked in accordance with the requirements specified in relation to that description of wireless telegraphy apparatus in the Schedule to that Order.

(2) No person shall, in the Bailiwick of Guernsey, in the course of any trade or business, supply or offer to supply wireless telegraphy apparatus which does not comply with the marking requirements referred to in subsection (1).

**Repeals.**

4. The following orders are repealed-

- (a) the Wireless Telegraphy Apparatus Order, 1994(f);
- (b) the Wireless Telegraphy (Citizens' Band and Amateur Apparatus) (Various Provisions) Order, 1995(g); and
- (c) the Wireless Telegraphy (Cordless Telephone Apparatus) (Restriction) Order, 1995(h).

**Interpretation.**

5. (1) The provisions of the Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948(i) shall apply to the interpretation of this order throughout the Bailiwick of Guernsey.

(2) Expressions used in this order have the meanings (if any) given by the Wireless Telegraphy Apparatus (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1994.

(3) Any reference in this order to an enactment or statutory instrument (whether made in Guernsey or the United Kingdom) is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, replaced or re-enacted (in either case, with or without modification), extended or applied (in each case whether before or after the date of the commencement of this order).

Citation.

6. This order may be cited as the Wireless Telegraphy Apparatus (Restriction) Order, 1996.

Extent.

7. This order shall have effect throughout the Bailiwick of Guernsey.

Commencement.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

This order, made under the Wireless Telegraphy Apparatus (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1994, prohibits, for the purpose of preventing or reducing the risk of interference with wireless telegraphy, the manufacture, sale, possession and importation of wireless telegraphy apparatus which does not comply with prescribed technical standards. The restrictions are the same as those applied in relation to such apparatus in the United Kingdom.
