**GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT**

**The Health Service (Payment of Authorised Suppliers) (Amendment No.2) Regulations, 1997**

THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 14 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment

1. In Part II of the Second Schedule to the Health Service (Payment of Authorised Suppliers) Regulations, 1990, as amended(b) substitute the provisions set out in the Schedule to these Regulations for the following description of pharmaceutical benefit and additional dispensing fee.

Description of pharmaceutical benefit	Additional dispensing fee
Where an item or pharmaceutical benefit is a controlled drug within the meaning of the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1974 and it has been supplied on a prescription endorsed with the initial letters "C.D." by an authorised supplier.	£1.93

<p>Where an item of pharmaceutical benefit contains Methadone Hydrochloride and has been ordered by an approved Medical Practitioner as part of an approved Methadone maintenance programme and the taking of the drug has been supervised by an authorised supplier and supplied on a prescription endorsed with the initial letters “SUP” by an authorised supplier.</p>	<p>£1.93</p>

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## EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These Regulations further amend the Health Service (Payment of Authorised Suppliers) Regulations, 1990, as amended:

- (i) to provide a new fee for controlled drugs in Schedule 3 of the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 1997; and
- (ii) to introduce a supervision fee for the administration of Methadone to patients being treated under an approved Methadone maintenance programme.
