**The Health Service (Pharmaceutical)
(Prescribed Appliances) (Amendment)
(Guernsey) Regulations, 1990**

Made 15th August, 1990.
Laid before the States 26th September, 1990.
Coming into operation 1st September, 1990.

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 23 and 29 of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Guernsey) Law, 1972, as amended, and as modified by section 1 of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Prescribed Appliances) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1977(a), hereby orders:—

Amendment to the Regulations of 1977

1. The Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Prescribed Appliances) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1977, as amended(b), are hereby further amended as follows:—

in Regulation 8 thereof paragraph (2) is repealed and the following paragraph is substituted therefor—

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport)

These Regulations further amend the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Prescribed Appliances) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1977 so as to provide for an adjustment to the payments due in respect of the supply of prescribed appliances by different classes of approved appliance suppliers.

Extent

2. These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

Citation

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Prescribed Appliances) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1990.

Collective title

4. These Regulations and the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Prescribed Appliances) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1977 to 1989, may be cited together as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Prescribed Appliances) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1977 to 1990.

Commencement

5. These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1st day of September, 1990.

- (d) as regards an approved appliance supplier of any class, where the appliance is an appliance of any of the descriptions specified in Part I or Part II of the First Schedule to these Regulations, a container allowance of 6 pence.”.

Supplemental payment to suppliers of prescribed appliances

2. An approved appliance supplier within the meaning of the said Regulations of 1977 shall be paid out of the Guernsey Health Service Fund in respect of each prescribed appliance within the meaning of the said regulations—

- (a) which was supplied by him under the said Law of 1972 during the period commencing on the 1st day of March, 1989 and ending on the 28th day of February, 1990, and
- (b) in respect of which payment was made out of that Fund upon the receipt by the Authority of a certificate relating to any part of that period and issued by the body appointed by the Authority to calculate the sum payable to approved suppliers in respect of pharmaceutical benefit supplied by them under the Law;

in addition to that payment, a sum equal to—

- (a) 3.9287 per centum of the amount paid, where he is a medical practitioner;
- (b) 4.6208 per centum of the amount paid, where he is not a medical practitioner.

“ (2) Subject to the provisions of the next following paragraph, an approved appliance supplier shall be paid out of the Fund in respect of any appliance supplied by him under the Law the sum of the following amounts, that is to say:—

- (a) as regards an approved appliance supplier of any class, an amount equal to the amount of the basic price of the appliance;
- (b) as regards an approved appliance supplier who is—
 - (i) a dentist, 13.5 per centum of that amount;
 - (ii) a medical practitioner, 13.5 per centum of that amount;
 - (iii) a pharmacist, 20.8 per centum of that amount;
 - (iv) not a dentist, medical practitioner or pharmacist, 20.8 per centum of that amount;
- (c) as regards an approved appliance supplier who is—
 - (i) a dentist, a dispensing fee of 32.5p per item;
 - (ii) a medical practitioner, a dispensing fee of 32.5p per item;
 - (iii) a pharmacist, a dispensing fee of 32p per item;
 - (iv) not a dentist, medical practitioner or pharmacist, 32p per item;
