THE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF GOODS (CONTROL)(GUERNSEY) ORDER, 1978

AMENDMENT NO.1 TO THE OPEN GENERAL IMPORT LICENCE OF 1980

THE BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION in pursuance of its powers under Article 3 of the Import and Export of Goods (Control)(Guernsey) Order, 1978 (a) hereby modifies the Open General Import Licence dated the 19th day of August 1980 (b) as follows:-

1. In Schedule 1 thereof, after the entry relating to "ex 85.15" there shall be added the following entry:-

"ex 85.15 Wireless telegraphy apparatus consisting of W
radio telephonic apparatus capable of transmitting
on any frequency between 26.1 and 29.7 megacycles
per second or between 88 and 108 megacycles per
second and notwithstanding that the said apparatus
is also capable of transmitting on other
frequencies outside the said limits."

2. This Amendment shall take effect on the twenty-second day of July, nineteen hundred and eighty-one.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Amendment to the Open General Import Licence but is intended to indicate its general purport).

The effect of this Amendment is to prohibit the importation of certain wireless telegraphy apparatus consigned from a place outside the United Kingdom, the Island of Jersey, the other Islands of the Bailiwick of Guernsey or the Isle of Man, except under the authority of an Individual Import Licence.
