THE MISUSE OF DRUGS (DESIGNATION) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1991

Made 6 June 1991
 Laid before the States 1991
 Coming into operation 1 July 1991

THE STATES BOARD OF HEALTH, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 6(4) of the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1974(a), as amended (b), hereby orders:-

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Misuse of Drugs (Designation) (Amendment) Order, 1991 and shall come into operation on 1 July, 1991.

Amendment to Order of 1989

2. Paragraph 1(a) of Part I of the Schedule of the Misuse of Drugs (Designation) Order, 1989(c) shall be amended by the insertion after the word "2,5-Dimethoxy- α , 4-dimethylphenethylamine", of "N-Hydroxy-tenamphetamine" and "4-Methyl-aminorex".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order varies the Misuse of Drugs (Designation) Order 1989 by adding to Part 1 of the Schedule (which specifies the controlled drugs which are designated as drugs to which section 6(4) of the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law 1974 applies) N-Hydroxy-tenamphetamine and 4-Methyl-aminorex.

These drugs become subject to control under the Law by virtue of the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law 1974 (Modification) Ordinance 1991.

The Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law 1974 (Modification) Ordinance 1991

1. This Ordinance adds N-Hydroxy-tenamphetamine and 4-Methyl-aminorex to the list of Class A drugs specified in Part I of the First Schedule to the 1974 Law. The maximum penalties appropriate to offences involving Class A drugs are specified in the Third Schedule to the Law (as amended).

The Misuse of Drugs (Designation) (Amendment) Order 1991

2. Because neither N-Hydroxy-tenamphetamine nor 4-Methyl-aminorex is used for therapeutic purposes this Order adds them to the list of drugs which the Board has designated under section 6(4) of the 1974 Law as drugs in relation to which it is in the public interest that their production, supply and possession shall be unlawful except for the purposes of research or other special purposes carried out under licence of the Board.


3. This Ordinance adds N-hydroxy-tenamphetamine and 4-Methyl-aminorex, as with other drugs designated under section 6(4) of the 1974 Law, to the list of drugs specified in the Fourth Schedule to the Misuse of Drugs (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance 1976 (as amended).
4. These changes will come into effect (subject to States approval) on 1 July 1991.

5. For the avoidance of doubt, the undermentioned substances are included in the list of Class C drugs under UK legislation but are not yet controlled drugs under Bailiwick legislation:-
