The Post Office (Money Order) (Amendment) Order, 1977

Made 10th June, 1977
Laid before the States ... 1977
Coming into Operation ... 13th June, 1977

THE STATES POST OFFICE BOARD, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections twenty-nine, thirty-three and sixty-eight of the Post Office (Guernsey) Law, 1969, as amended (a), hereby orders:-

- Amendment to Order of 1975. 1. In subsection (1) of section thirteen of the Post Office (Money Order) Order, 1975, as amended (b), the words "two pounds" are hereby repealed and the words "three pounds" are hereby substituted therefor.
- Repeal. 2. The Post Office (Money Order) (Amendment) Order, 1975 (c), is hereby repealed.
- Citation. 3. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Money Order) (Amendment) Order, 1977.
- Commencement. 4. This Order shall come into force on the thirteenth day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-seven.
- Dated this *Tenth* day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-seven.
