THE STATES POST OFFICE BOARD, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections 29, 30, 33 and 68 of the Post Office (Guernsey) Law, 1969, as amended (a), hereby orders:-

1. The Schedule of the Post Office (Postal Order) Order, 1983, as amended (b), is repealed and the Schedule set out in this Order is substituted therefor.


Citation.
