The Weights and Measures (Designated Countries) Regulations, 1993

THE STATES BOARD OF EMPLOYMENT, INDUSTRY AND COMMERCE, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 61(1), 68(1) and Schedule 10 of the Weights and Measures (Guernsey and Alderney) Law, 1991(a) and in exercise of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations -

1. Northern Ireland, the Isle of Man and Jersey shall be designated countries for the purposes of sections 4(2), 20(2)(a) and 29(1)(d) of the Weights and Measures (Guernsey and Alderney) Law, 1991.

2. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948(b) applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as if they were an enactment.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Weights and Measures (Designated Countries) Regulations, 1993.

4. These Regulations shall come into operation on 27th July, 1993.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

The Weights and Measures (Guernsey and Alderney) Law, 1991 contains a number of provisions relating to the regulation of trade and weighing or measuring equipment used for trade which do not apply in relation to goods for "despatch to a destination outside the Bailiwick, Great Britain and any designated country".

These Regulations declare Northern Ireland, the Isle of Man and Jersey to be designated countries for the purposes of these provisions which will in future apply in relation to goods intended for despatch to those countries.
