The Health Service (Medical Appliances) (Amendment) Regulations, 1995

THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 15, 16, 18 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990, as amended (a), hereby orders:-

Amendment

1. The Health Service (Medical Appliances) Regulations, 1990, as amended (b) are amended as follows:-

(a) After Regulation 4(10) insert -

"(11) Subject to the provisions of the next following paragraph an authorised appliance supplier may supply Part I or Part II appliances on a copy appliance prescription within a period of 4 days immediately preceding the date specified in the copy prescription.

(12) An authorised appliance supplier may supply Part I or Part II appliances on a copy appliance prescription within a period of 30 days immediately preceding the date specified in the copy prescription where the person in respect of whom the appliance prescription is required will be temporarily absent from Guernsey or Alderney, as the case may be, on the date specified in the copy prescription".

(b) After "shall not" in Regulation 11(1A) insert -

"subject to the provisions of the next following paragraph",

(c) After Regulation 11(1A) insert -

"(1B) When the person, in respect of whom the Part III appliance is required, will be temporarily absent from Guernsey or Alderney, as the case may be, when his supply of Part III appliances is due to be exhausted, an authorised supplier may supply Part III appliances under the Law for that person in a quantity not exceeding that which is reasonably requisite for that person's treatment for a period of sixty days."


Citation

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Medical Appliances) (Amendment) Regulations, 1995.

Commencement

3. These Regulations shall come into operation on the 12th day of July, 1995.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These Regulations provide for -

- (a) Copy appliance prescriptions for Part I and Part II medical appliances to be dispensed up to 4 days before the date in the prescription unless the person for whom the appliance prescription is required is temporarily absent from Guernsey or Alderney, as the case may be on the date specified in the prescription in which case an authorised supplier may supply the Part I or Part II appliances ordered on a copy prescription within a period of 30 days immediately preceding the date specified in the copy prescription.
- (b) Part III appliances to be supplied to persons in respect of whom the Part III appliance is required in a quantity not exceeding that which is requisite for that person's treatment for a period of 60 days providing that person will be temporarily absent from Guernsey or Alderney, as the case may be, when his supply of Part III appliances is due to be exhausted.
