**The Policy & Finance Committee** in exercise of its powers under Section 2 and 3 of the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Alderney) Order, 1995(a) hereby grants the following Open General Import Licence:—

1. Dairy Products comprised in the entry in Schedule 1 to the above mentioned Order may, under the authority of this Licence, be imported into the Island from the United Kingdom, the Isle of Man, Jersey and any Member States of the European Community provided they have been pasteurised in accordance with EC Regulations;
2. Dogs and Cats comprised in entry 5 in Schedule 1 to the above mentioned Order may, under the authority of this Licence, be imported into the Island from the United Kingdom, Jersey and the Isle of Man, provided that prior to importation the importer receives an Import Permit from the States of Alderney Policy & Finance Committee and this Import Permit is presented to Customs on arrival in Alderney except that dogs of the type commonly known as the Pit Bull Terrier, the type of dog known as the Japanese Tosa (or Tosa) or any other type of dog which appears to have been bred for fighting are excluded from this licence;
3. (a) Feeding stuffs intended to be fed to animals;  
(b) Fertiliser intended to be spread on, or worked into the soil to increase its capacity to support plant growth containing any natural, manufactured or processed material;  
(c) Hay, straw including chaffed hay, chaffed straw and hay and straw chaffed together;

- (d) Litter including straw or any other substance commonly used for bedding or otherwise for or about animals; may, under the authority of this Licence, be imported into the Island provided that prior to importation, the importer receives an import Permit from the States of Alderney Policy & Finance Committee;
4. An Import Permit issued under the provisions of paragraphs 2 and 3 may contain such conditions as the States Policy & Finance Committee considers necessary.
  5.
    - (a) a carcass of an animal from the United Kingdom or the Republic of Ireland or any products made or processed therefrom prior to the 1 February 2001;
    - (b) the carcass of an animal from the Member States of the European Union except the United Kingdom, the Republics of Ireland and France or any products made or processed therefrom;
    - (c) a carcass of an animal from the list of approved countries set down in the Schedule to the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Alderney) (Amendment No 2) Order, 2001(b) and any products made or processed therefrom;
    - (d) the carcass of, or any product made or processed from poultry;
    - (e) fully cooked meats or products containing fully cooked meats;
    - (f) tinned meats;
    - (g) pre-cooked meals; and
    - (h) exotic meats.
  6. The Open General Import Licence made the 8 day of March 2001 is hereby revoked.
  7. This Licence shall come into effect on the 15 March 2001.
