The Post Office (Miscellaneous Amendments) (No.2) Order, 1981

Made 21st July 1981

Laid before the States ..

Coming into Operation ... 1st August 1981

THE STATES POST OFFICE BOARD, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, eighteen, nineteen, twenty, twenty-three, twenty-eight and sixty-eight of the Post Office (Guernsey) Law, 1969, as amended (a), hereby orders:-

1. The Post Office (Inland Post) Order, 1973, as amended (b), is further amended as follows:-

(a) subsection (2) of section seventeen thereof is repealed and the following subsection is substituted therefor -

"(2) In respect of every packet brought into the Bailiwick by post from the United Kingdom, the Isle of Man or Jersey to which the provisions of such Ordinance as aforesaid apply, and upon the contents of which any tax, duty or impôt is payable, and the Board so directs, there shall be charged and paid by the addressee upon delivery the further fee of fifty-five new pence.";

(b) sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (a) of subsection (3) of section seventeen thereof is repealed and the following sub-paragraph is substituted therefor -

"(ii) the sender shall mark on the cover of the parcel the words "To be delivered free of charges" or the words "Franc de droits";";

- (c) the full stop at the end of sub-paragraph (iv) of paragraph (a) of subsection (3) of section seventeen thereof is repealed and a semi-colon is substituted thereafter and immediately thereafter there is inserted the following additional sub-paragraph numbered "(v)" -
- "(v) the sender shall also pay to the Board at the time that any amount is paid in accordance with sub-paragraph (i), or repaid by the Board in accordance with sub-paragraph (iv), of this paragraph a fee of forty-five new pence."

2. The Post Office (Overseas Letter Post) Order, 1973, as amended (c), is further amended as follows:-

3. The Post Office (Overseas Parcel Post) Order, 1973, as amended (d), is further amended as follows:-

- (a) in paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section sixteen thereof the words "thirty-five new pence" are repealed and the words "forty-five new pence" are substituted therefor;
- (b) in subsection (2) of section twenty thereof the words "twenty-five new pence" are repealed and the words "thirty-five new pence" are substituted therefor.

4. Sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (e) of section two of the Post Office (Miscellaneous Amendments) Order, 1977 (e); the Post Office (Inland Post) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1979 (f) and paragraph (b) of section one of the Post Office (Inland Post) (Amendment) Order, 1980 (g) are hereby repealed.

Citation.

5. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Miscellaneous Amendments) (No. 2) Order, 1981.

Commencement.

6. This Order shall come into force on the first day of August nineteen hundred and eighty-one.
