The Social Insurance (Increase of Benefit)
(Guernsey) Regulations, 1985

Made 25th September, 1985

Laid before the States

Coming into operation 11th November, 1985

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 27, section 39, and section 50 of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended^(a), and by Part II of the Fourth Schedule to that Law, hereby orders:-

Interpretation

1. (1) In these Regulations, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say:-

"the Law" means the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978;

"the relevant day" means the 11th day of November, 1985;

and any other expressions have the same meanings as in the Law.

(2) Except where the context otherwise requires, any reference in these Regulations to any enactment or regulations shall be construed as including a reference to that enactment or those regulations, as the case may be, as amended, repealed, replaced or revoked by or under any other enactment or by any other regulations.

(3) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law 1948^(b), shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.

Higher rates of widow's benefit and old age pension payable at reduced rates owing to partial satisfaction of contribution conditions

2. The Schedule to the Social Insurance (Widow's Benefit and Old Age Pensions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended^(c), is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the First Schedule to these Regulations is hereby substituted therefor.

Higher rates of sickness benefit and invalidity benefit payable at reduced rates owing to partial satisfaction of contribution conditions

3. (1) The Second Schedule to the Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended^(d), is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the second Schedule to these Regulations is hereby substituted therefor.

(2) The Third Schedule to the Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended^(d), is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the Third Schedule to these Regulations is hereby substituted therefor.

Higher rates of unemployment benefit payable at reduced rates owing to partial satisfaction of contribution conditions

4. The Fifth Schedule to the Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended^(d), is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the Fourth Schedule to these Regulations is hereby substituted therefor.

Higher rates of maternity allowance payable at reduced rates owing to partial satisfaction of contribution conditions

5. The First Schedule to the Social Insurance (Benefits) (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended ^(e), is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the Fifth Schedule to these Regulations is hereby substituted therefor.

Transitional provisions regarding the payment of the increased amount of maternity grant

6. Where a woman has become entitled to a maternity grant (whether payment has been made or not) before the relevant day and her confinement occurs on or after that day, or, as the case may be, her pregnancy is otherwise terminated on or after that day, she shall be entitled to a maternity grant at the rate specified in Part III of the Schedule to the Social Insurance (Rates of Contributions and Benefits, etc.) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1985 ^(f).

Higher amounts of death grant payable at reduced amounts owing to partial satisfaction of contribution conditions

7. The Second Schedule to the Social Insurance (Benefits) (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended ^(g), is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the Sixth Schedule to these Regulations is hereby substituted therefor.

Higher rates of increase of industrial disablement benefit under section 50 of the Law where constant attendance is required

8. The Second Schedule to the Social Insurance (Industrial Injuries Benefits) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended ^(h), is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the Seventh Schedule to these Regulations is hereby substituted therefor.

Amendments to Social Insurance (Benefits) (Transitional Provisions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978

9. The Social Insurance (Benefits) (Transitional Provisions) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended ⁽ⁱ⁾, are hereby further amended as follows:-

- (a) in sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (2) of Regulation 19 thereof, the words "twelve pounds" are hereby repealed and the words "thirteen pounds and twenty pence" are substituted therefor;

Amendment to Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978

10. Sub-paragraph (f) of paragraph (1) of Regulation 6 of the Social Insurance (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidity Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended (j), shall have effect, on or after the 1st day of January, 1985, as if for the words "sixteen pounds" therein there were substituted the words "seventeen pounds". 1986*

Repeal

11.(1) Regulation 10 of the Social Insurance (Increase of Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1984^(k) is hereby repealed.

(2) Regulations 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 11 of the Social Insurance (Increase of Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1984^(k), and the First, Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth, Sixth and Seventh Schedules to those Regulations are hereby repealed.

Extent

12. These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

Citation

13. These Regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Increase of Benefit) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1985.

Commencement

14.(1) Paragraph (1) of Regulation 11 of these Regulations shall come into force on the 30th day of September, 1985.

(2) These Regulations, other than paragraph (1) of Regulation 11 thereof, shall come into force on the 11th day of November, 1985.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These regulations increase the reduced rates of widow's benefits, old age pension, unemployment benefit, sickness benefit, invalidity benefit and maternity allowance payable under the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, in order to bring them into correspondence with the higher standard rates of such benefits approved by the States on the 26th June 1985 (regulations 2, 3, 4 and 5); increase the reduced amounts of death grant payable under that Law in order to bring them into correspondence with the higher standard amount of death grant approved by the States as aforesaid (regulation 7); and revise the rates of increase of industrial disablement benefit where constant attendance is required (regulation 8). The remaining provisions of these regulations effect minor consequential and other amendments.
