THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section twelve of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Guernsey) Law, 1972(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of Second Schedule to the principal regulations

1. The Second Schedule to the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1983(b) (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations"), is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the First Schedule to these regulations is hereby substituted therefor.

Amendment of Third Schedule to the principal regulations

2. The Third Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the Second Schedule to these regulations is hereby substituted therefor.


Citation, collective title and commencement

3. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical)(Payment of Approved Suppliers)(Amendment)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1983.

(2) These regulations and the principal regulations may be cited together as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical)(Payment of Approved Suppliers)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1983, as amended.

(3) These regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation on the first day of June, nineteen hundred and eighty-three.

Additional dispensing fees payable in respect of pharmaceutical benefit supplied on medical prescriptions endorsed "URGENT" or "DISPENSED URGENTLY" in accordance with regulation three.

On any day, other than a Sunday and a bank holiday, between the time the premises of the approved supplier are closed for the supply of pharmaceutical benefit and eleven o'clock in the afternoon.	£7.25

On any day between eleven o'clock in the afternoon of the next previous day and nine o'clock in the forenoon or such earlier time at which the premises of the approved supplier are open for the supply of pharmaceutical benefit.	£9.25

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EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport)

These Regulations amend the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Payment of Approved Suppliers)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1983 so as to provide for an increase in the fees payable in respect of certain items of pharmaceutical benefit which are extemporaneously dispensed or are dispensed urgently.
