Import and Export (Control) (Alderney) Law, 1946

**Import and Export of Goods (Control)
(Alderney) (Amendment) (No 3) Order, 2001**

Made	30 April 2001
Coming into force	30 April 2001

The States of Alderney Policy & Finance Committee (“the Committee”) in pursuance of the powers conferred by Article 1 of the Import and Export (Control) (Alderney) Law, 1946(a) **HEREBY ORDER**:-

1. In the Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Alderney) Order 1995(b) as amended, delete sections 5A and 5B and replace with the following sections:-
 - “5A. The importation into Alderney of fresh meat, meat products, minced meat and meat preparations from or using meat from cattle, sheep, goats and pigs from any country not being a Member State of the European Community or excluded from the list of approved countries set out in Schedule A of this Order, is prohibited;
 - 5B. The importation into Alderney of fresh poultry meat and poultry meat products from any country not being a Member State of the European Union or excluded from the list of approved countries set out in Schedule B of this Order is prohibited;
 - 5C. The importation into Alderney of fresh meat, meat products, minced meat and meat preparations from or using meat produced from cattle, sheep, goats and pigs from the United Kingdom, the Republic of Ireland or the Netherlands, is prohibited;
 - 5D. The importation into Alderney of:-

- (i) fresh meat, meat products, minced meat and meat preparations from or using meat produced from cattle, sheep, goats, pigs and game animals from Guernsey, Jersey and countries included on the list of approved countries set out in Schedule A of this Order
- (ii) fresh poultry meat, poultry meat products from Guernsey, Jersey and the countries included on the list of approved countries set out in Schedule B of this Order
- (iii) fresh and fully cooked poultry meat, poultry meat products, poultry meat preparations and meat from game birds from any Member State of the European Community, Guernsey and Jersey
- (iv) fresh and fully cooked meat, meat products, minced meat, and meat preparations from Guernsey and Jersey
- (v) fully cooked meat, fully cooked meat products and fully cooked meat preparations from or using meat from cattle, sheep, goats, pigs, poultry, game animals and game birds from the United Kingdom, the Republic of Ireland and the Netherlands
- (vi) fresh and fully cooked meat, meat products, minced meat and meat preparations from or using meat products from cattle, sheep, goats, pigs and game animals from any Member State of the European Community other than the United Kingdom, the Republic of Ireland or the Netherlands
- (vii) exotic meat
- (viii) pigeons, including racing pigeons from any country

are prohibited other than under the authority of a licence issued by the Committee under the provisions of Section 2.

2. In this Order, the following meanings shall apply:

“carcass” means the carcass of any animal or any part thereof;

“cattle” includes veal and buffalo meat;

“exotic meat” means the meat of alligator, kangaroo and ostrich;

“fresh meat” means meat that is fit for human consumption that has not undergone any preserving process other than chilling or freezing;

“fresh poultry meat” means any part of the carcass of poultry that is fit for human consumption that has not undergone any preserving process other than chilling or freezing;

“**fully cooked meat**” means subject to heat that is sufficient to achieve a core temperature of 68°C or greater;

“**game animals**” means rabbit, hare, wild boar and deer and includes animals that have been farmed or taken from the wild;

“**game birds**” means guinea fowl, pheasant, and partridge and includes birds that have been farmed or taken from the wild;

“**meat from cattle**” includes veal and buffalo meat;

“**meat products**” means products prepared wholly or partly from meat that is fit for human consumption which has undergone a certain degree of preservation (other than chilling or freezing) and does not include meat extracts, consomme, stock or sauces;

“**meat preparations**” means fresh meat to which foodstuffs, seasonings or additives have been added;

“**minced meat**” means fresh meat minced into fragments;

“**poultry**” means domestic fowl, turkeys, geese, ducks, guinea fowl, pheasant and partridge;

“**poultry meat preparations**” means fresh poultry meat to which foodstuffs, seasonings or additives have been added;

“**poultry meat products**” means products prepared wholly or partly from poultry meat that is fit for human consumption which has undergone a certain degree of preservation (other than chilling or freezing). This does not include meat extracts, consomme, stock or sauces.

3. The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948(c) applies to the Interpretation of the Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.
4. The Import and Export of Goods (Control) (Alderney) (Amendment) (No 2) Order, 2001(d) is hereby revoked.
5. This Order may be cited as The import and Export (Control) (Alderney) (Amendment) (No 3) Order, 2001.
6. This Order shall come into force on the 30 April 2001.
