

GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

The Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets) (No. 2)  
Regulations, 1987

Made: 1st June, 1987.

Coming into operation: 5th June, 1987.

THE ISLAND POLICE COMMITTEE, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article X of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Vehiculaire en cette Ile" of 2nd March, 1929 (a), and the Traffic Temporary Regulations Ordinance, 1950 (b), and of all powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations in order to ascertain the best method of regulating vehicular traffic in this Island:-

1. A person being in charge of a vehicle or an animal shall not, without the permission of the Chief Officer, drive or ride that vehicle or cause or permit that animal to proceed along La Rue Flere, Vale, otherwise than from west to east.

2. In these Regulations -

"animal" and "vehicle" have the meanings assigned to them by Article I of the Ordinance entitled "Ordonnance relative au Trafic Vehiculaire en cette Ile" of 2nd March 1929;

"Chief Officer" means the Chief Officer of the Island Police Force.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Prohibited and One-Way Streets) (No. 2) Regulations, 1987.

4. These Regulations shall come into force on the 5th day of June, 1987 and shall continue in force until the 30th day of November, 1987.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note forms no part of the Regulations but is intended to indicate their general purport)

The effect of these Regulations is that from 5th June, 1987 to 30th November, 1987 La Rue Flere, Vale will be a one-way street, traffic being required to travel from the direction of Juas Lane towards its junction with Les Juqueurs.
