**The Social Insurance (Classification) (Amendment)  
Regulations, 1994**

**THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY**, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 1 and 116 of the Social Insurance (Guernsey) Law, 1978, as amended(a), hereby orders:-

**Amendments**

1. Part I of the First Schedule to the Social Insurance (Classification) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978, as amended(b) (hereafter in these regulations referred to as "the principal regulations"), is hereby amended as follows:-

(a) in paragraph 4 of Column (B) thereof, for "None" substitute "Any person who performs the duties of such employment in his own home."

2. Part III of the First Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended as follows:-

(a) in paragraph 8(a) of Column (A) thereof for "£29.00" substitute "30.00";

(b) in paragraph 8(b) of Column (A) thereof for "£125.67" substitute "£130.00";

**Repeals**

3. (a) paragraph 12 in Column (A) and Column (B) of Part III of the First Schedule to the principal regulations is repealed;

- (b) regulations 1(a) and 1(b) of the Social Insurance (Classification) (Amendment) Regulations, 1993(c) are repealed.

**Extent**

3. These Regulations shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Alderney, Herm and Jethou.

**Citation**

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Social Insurance (Classification) (Amendment) Regulations, 1994.

**Commencement**

5. These Regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January, 1995.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport.)

These Regulations further amend the Social Insurance (Classification) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1978 so as to provide that an insured person who is employed under a contract of service at home can pay Social Insurance Contributions to qualify for benefits and a pension, modify the provisions relating to workers in horticulture to allow persons working from home to be classified as self-employed and increase the lower earnings limits to provide that an insured person with employment from which he derives weekly earnings of less than £30.00 or monthly earnings of less than £130.00 shall be treated as a non-employed person.
