**The Alderney Road Traffic and Public Highways
(Amendment) Regulations, 2009**

Made 5th March 2009
Coming into operation 15th June 2009

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY GENERAL SERVICES COMMITTEE,
in pursuance of their Resolution of the 5 March 2009, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 2 and 35 of the Alderney Road Traffic and Public Highways Ordinance, 1966, as amended^a and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of the regulations 12 of the 1986 Regulations.

1. In regulation 12 of the Traffic Regulations 1986, as amended^b, (referred to hereinafter as "**the 1986 Regulations**"), immediately after paragraph (2) insert the following paragraphs –

"(3) Every vehicle on a public highway shall, subject to paragraph (4), carry unobscured and in a clean, efficient and good working condition –

- (a) two lamps each showing to the rear a red light when braking that is visible from a reasonable distance ("**brake lights**"),
- (b) two sets of indicator lamps to the front and to the rear that are visible from a reasonable distance ("**indicators**").

(4) Paragraph (3) applies only to vehicles that have been fitted with brake lights or indicators."

Interpretation.

2. (1) In these Regulations expressions shall have the same meanings as in the 1986 Regulations.

(2) The Interpretation Guernsey (Law), 1948, shall apply to these Regulations as it applies to an enactment in force in the Island of Guernsey.

(3) Any reference in these Regulations to an enactment is a reference thereto as from time to time amended, re-enacted (with or without modification), extended or applied.

Citation.

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Alderney Road Traffic and Public Highways (Amendment) Regulations, 2009.

Commencement.

4. These regulations shall come into force on the 15 June 2009.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Alderney Road Traffic and Public Highways (Amendment) Regulations, 2009.

These Regulations amend the Traffic Regulations 1986 and insert a new obligation that requires every vehicle to have working brake lights and two sets of indicators. This requirement is conditional upon such brake lights or indicators having been fitted to the vehicle.
