

GUERNSEY STATUTORY INSTRUMENT

1985 - Number 2

The Guernsey Airport (Traffic) Order, 1985

Made the 29th day of January 1985.

Coming into force on the 11th day of February 1985.

THE STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by subsection (1) of section eleven of the Airport Ordinance, 1950, as amended (a), hereby orders:-

Application of the provisions of this Order

1. The provisions of this Order shall apply to any roadway (hereinafter referred to as "controlled road") and to any parking place (hereinafter referred to as "controlled parking place") on any land at the Guernsey Airport to which the public have access (hereinafter referred to as "controlled land").

Driving and parking of vehicles on controlled land

2. (1) Subject to the provisions of the next succeeding subsection, a person being in charge of a vehicle shall not, without the permission in writing of the Board -
  - (a) drive or ride that vehicle on or along any part of the controlled land otherwise than on a controlled road or controlled parking place;
  - (b) drive or ride that vehicle on or along a controlled road or controlled parking place otherwise than subject to such conditions, restrictions or prohibitions as the Board may, from time to time, order or direct, by means of a traffic sign erected, placed or marked on or near the controlled road or controlled parking place, as the case may be, by or on behalf of the Board;
  - (c) park that vehicle on any part of the controlled land otherwise than within a controlled parking place;
  - (d) park that vehicle on or within any controlled parking place otherwise than for such periods, during such hours and subject to such conditions, restrictions or prohibitions as the Board may, from time to time, order or direct, by means of a traffic sign erected, placed or marked on or near the controlled parking place by or on behalf of the Board.

- (2) The provisions of the last preceding subsection shall not apply to the driving or parking of a vehicle on any controlled land, controlled road or controlled parking place where such driving or parking, as the case may be, is in compliance with the order or direction of a police officer engaged in the regulation of traffic on such aforesaid land, road or parking place.

#### Meaning of traffic sign

3. In this Order the expression "traffic sign" means any object or device (whether fixed or portable) for conveying to traffic on a controlled road or in a controlled parking place information, conditions, restrictions or prohibitions of any description pursuant to the provisions of the last preceding section and any line or mark on a controlled road or controlled parking place for so conveying such information, conditions, restrictions or prohibitions.

#### Application of other enactments relating to the significance of traffic signs

4. Where a traffic sign erected, placed or marked on or near a controlled road or controlled parking place by or on behalf of the Board pursuant to the provisions of section two of this Order complies in its specifications with a traffic sign prescribed under the provisions of any enactment for the time being in force regulating its use on a public highway, such a traffic sign shall for the purposes of this Order, but only in the interpretation of its significance, convey the same information, conditions, restrictions or prohibitions, as the case may be, as if such traffic sign had been a traffic sign used on a public highway pursuant to the provisions of such aforesaid enactment.

#### Interpretation

5. (1) In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them, that is to say:-

"controlled land" has the meaning assigned to it in section one of this Order;

"controlled parking place" has the meaning assigned to it in section one of this Order;

"controlled road" has the meaning assigned to it in section one of this Order;

"enactment" includes any order, rule or regulation made in pursuance of any enactment;

"the Guernsey Airport" means the premises belonging to the States situate at La Villiaze and used from time to time for the landing and departure of aircraft or for purposes ancillary thereto;

"officer of police" means a member of the salaried police force of the Island of Guernsey and, within the limits of his jurisdiction, a member of the special constabulary of the Island of Guernsey;

"the Ordinance of 1950" means the Airport Ordinance, 1950;

"parking place", in relation to controlled land, means any area of land or any part of a controlled road set aside by order or direction of the Board as a parking place for vehicles;

"roadway", in relation to controlled land, means any roadway whatsoever set aside by order or direction of the Board as a way for vehicles;

and any other expressions have the same meanings as in the Ordinance of 1950.

(2) Except where the context otherwise requires, any reference in this Order to any other enactment shall be construed as including a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed or replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment including this Order.

(3) The Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948(b), shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an enactment.

#### Repeal

6. The Guernsey Airport - Traffic Order, 1970, is hereby repealed.

#### Citation

7. This Order may be cited as the Guernsey Airport (Traffic) Order, 1985.

#### Commencement

8. This Order shall come into force on the 11th day of February, nineteen hundred and eighty-five.
