The STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 46(1) of The Harbours Ordinance, 1988 (a) hereby makes the following Regulation:-

1 Interpretation.

Expressions used in these Regulations have the same meanings as in the Harbours Ordinance, 1988.

2 Bait Digging.

A person shall not, in either Harbour, without the permission of the Harbourmaster, dig for bait.


3 Citation.

These Regulations may be cited as the Harbours (Prohibition of Bait Digging) (Guernsey) Regulations 1994.

4 Commencement.

These Regulations should come into force on 31 DECEMBER 1993

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Regulation grants to the States Harbour Master the authority to control the digging of bait in either harbour and to decide, as appropriate, where such activity may take place, in either harbour.
