

THE STATES BOARD OF ADMINISTRATION, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section 33 (1) of the Immigration Act 1971, as extended to the Bailiwick of Guernsey by the Immigration (Guernsey) Order 1972, as varied by the Immigration (Guernsey) (Variation) Order 1982 and the Criminal Justice Act 1982 (Guernsey) Order 1983, hereby orders:-

1. The fee to be paid by an employer on an application for a work permit shall be £10.
2. The Immigration (Work Permit Fee) (Guernsey) Order, 1989 (a) is repealed.
3. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Work Permit Fee) (Guernsey) Order, 1990.
4. This Order shall come into force on the twentieth-sixth day of February 1990.

This Order increases to £10 the fee for a work permit to be paid by an employer engaging in his employment persons who do not have the right of abode. The fee is to be paid on submitting the application.
