The Post Office (Miscellaneous Amendments) Order, 1980

Coming into Operation ... 12th February 1980

THE STATES POST OFFICE BOARD, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by sections thirteen, sixteen, eighteen, nineteen, twenty-three, twenty-eight and sixty-eight of the Post Office (Guernsey) Law, 1969, as amended (a), hereby orders:-

1. The Post Office (Overseas Letter Post) Order, 1973, as amended (b), is hereby further amended as follows:-

- (a) in Part I of the Arrangement of Sections thereof the entry "1. Letters and postcards." is repealed and the entry "1. Letters and postcards other than air mail packets." is substituted therefor;
- (b) in Part III of the Arrangement of Sections thereof the entry "34. Advice of delivery and enquiries." is repealed and the entry "34. Advice of delivery, international reply coupons and enquiries." is substituted therefor;

(c) in the Schedules under the Arrangement of Sections thereof the entries "2. Countries or places specified". and "3. Other rates of postage." are repealed and the entries "2. Other rates of postage." and "3. Rates of postage on air mail packets." are respectively substituted therefor;

(d) section four thereof is repealed and the following section is substituted therefor -

"4. (1) No postage shall be payable on an outgoing packet consisting of literature for the blind if, when posted -

(a) it is within the limit of weight for such packet as specified in the Fifth Schedule to this Order;

(b) it is accepted for conveyance by surface mail.

(2) There shall be charged and paid on each outgoing packet consisting of literator for the blind, when such a packet is accepted for conveyance by air mail, the rates of postage specified in Part 1 of the Third Schedule to this Order.";

(e) subsection (1) of section six thereof is repealed and the following section is substituted therefor -

"6. (1) There shall be charged and paid -

(a) on every air letter of the smaller size, a rate of postage of fourteen new pence;

(b) on every air letter of the larger size, a rate of postage of 14.5p;

(c) on every Forces air letter, a rate of postage of 9.5p;

(d) on other air mail packets, the rates of postage specified in the Third Schedule to this Order.";

(f) in subsection (3) of section twelve thereof the words STRT "forty-five new pence" are repealed and the words "fifty-five new pence" are substituted therefor;

(g) in paragraph (c) of subsection (2) of section twenty-seven thereof the words "sixty-five new pence" are repealed and the words "seventy-five new pence" are substituted therefor;

(h) in paragraph (d) of subsection (1) of section thirty thereof the words "seven hundred and fifty pounds" are repealed and the words "eight hundred pounds" are substituted therefor;

(i) in paragraph (b) of the proviso to subsection (1) of section thirty-one thereof the words "seven hundred and fifty pounds" are repealed and the words "eight hundred pounds" are substituted therefor;

(j) in section thirty-four thereof -

(i) the heading "Advice of delivery and enquiries" is repealed and the heading "Advice of delivery, international reply coupons and enquiries" is substituted therefor;

(ii) subsection "(2)" is renumbered as subsection "(3)" and immediately after subsection (1) there is inserted the following additional subsection numbered "(2)" -

"(2) International Reply Coupons may be purchased from post offices in the Bailiwick of Guernsey and can be exchanged for a stamp or stamps representing the minimum international postage payable on a letter sent by overseas surface letter mail.";

(k) in the Fourth Schedule thereof the words and figure "referred to in Part 4" are repealed and the words and figure "referred to in Part 1" are substituted therefor;

(l) the First, Second, Third, Sixth and Seventh Schedules thereto are repealed and the Schedules set out in the First, Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth Schedules to this Order are respectively substituted therefor.

2. The Post Office (Overseas Parcel Post) Order, 1973, as amended (c), is hereby further amended as follows:-

(a) in section five thereof the words "forty-five new pence" are repealed and the words "fifty-five new pence" are substituted therefor;

(b) paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section sixteen thereof is repealed and the following paragraph is substituted therefor -

"(b) the sender shall also pay to the Board at the time that any amount is paid in accordance with the undertaking referred to in paragraph (a) of this subsection or repaid by the Board in accordance with paragraph (e) of this subsection a fee of thirty-five new pence for each parcel posted;"

- (c) in paragraph (e) of subsection (1) of section seventeen thereof the words "seven hundred and fifty pounds" are repealed and the words "eight hundred pounds" are substituted therefor;
- (d) in paragraph (c) of the proviso to subsection (1) of section eighteen thereof the words "seven hundred and fifty pounds" are repealed and the words "eight hundred pounds" are substituted therefor;
- (e) paragraph (a) of subsection (5) of section twenty-one thereof is repealed and the following paragraph is substituted therefor -

"(a) where a parcel or parcels are stored for a period not exceeding twenty-eight days, the fee shall be one pound and seventy new pence for each parcel, except where two or more parcels are posted simultaneously by a sender to the same addressee, when the fee shall be:-

- (i) where there are not more than five parcels, one pound and forty new pence for each parcel
- (ii) where there are more than five parcels but not more than thirty, one pound and forty new pence for each of the first five parcels and then eighty new pence for each additional parcel;
- (iii) where there are more than thirty parcels, for the first thirty parcels the fee for each as prescribed in sub-paragraph (ii) of paragraph (a) of this subsection, fifty pence for each additional parcel after the first thirty up to three hundred, and then forty-five new pence for each additional parcel thereafter;"

9p for first 10 g. in weight; 3p for each additional 10 g.
- (f) Registered newspaper to Zone C:  
9.5p for first 10 g. in weight; 3.5p for each additional 10 g.
- (g) Packet consisting of or containing only literature for the blind to:
  - (a) Europe:  
not exceeding 1 kg. in weight - postage free  
exceeding 1 kg. but not exceeding 7 kg. in weight - 1p for each  
50 g. or part of 50 g. in weight.
  - (b) Zone A, Zone B or Zone C:  
1p for each 50 g. or part of 50 g. in weight
