The Companies (Fees) Regulations, 1995

Made	3rd May, 1995.
Coming into operation	3rd May, 1995.

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY FINANCE COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 108(7) and 153(1) of the Companies (Alderney) Law, 1994(a), hereby makes the following regulations:—

Procureur's fee for restoration of company name to Register.

1. For the purposes of section 108(7) of the Companies (Alderney) Law, 1994 the prescribed fee shall be £100.

Registrar's fee for certificate of good standing.

2. For the purposes of section 153(1) of the said Law the prescribed fee shall be £25.

Interpretation.

3. The provisions of the Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948(b) shall apply to the interpretation of these regulations.

Citation.

4. These regulations may be cited as the Companies (Fees) Regulations, 1995.

Commencement.

5. These regulations shall come into operation on the 3rd day of May, 1995.

These regulations prescribe fees payable to Her Majesty's Procureur in respect of the restoration of a company's name to the Register, and to the Registrar in respect of applications for certificates of good standing, for the purposes of the Companies (Alderney) Law, 1994.
