**The Health Service (Payment of Authorised Suppliers) (Amendment)
Regulations, 2007**

THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 14 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990, as amended^(a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendments.

1. In the Health Service (Payment of Authorised Suppliers) Regulations, 2003^(b), for Part I of the First Schedule substitute the provisions set out in the Schedule to these Regulations.

Interpretation.

2. The Interpretation Guernsey Law, 1948 shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of a Guernsey enactment.


Citation.

Commencement.

4. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January 2007.

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EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These Regulations amend the Health Service (Payment of Authorised Suppliers) Regulations, 2003 by increasing the graduated fees paid to pharmacists not employed by a medical practice.
