The States of Alderney General Services Committee in pursuance of powers vested in it by section 11 of the Alderney Road Traffic and Public Highways Ordinance, 1966, as amended, hereby orders :-

**Amendment to the Schedule**

1. For the Schedule to the Public Vehicle Regulations, 1986, there is substituted the following :-
