THE GUERNSEY SOCIAL SECURITY AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sections 15 and 35 of the Health Service (Benefit) (Guernsey) Law, 1990, as amended^(a), hereby orders:-

Amendment

1. For Part III of the First Schedule to the Health Service (Medical Appliances) Regulations, 1990, as amended^(b), substitute the Schedule set out in these Regulations.

Citation

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Medical Appliances) (Amendment) Regulations, 2001.

Commencement

3. These Regulations shall come into operation on the 1st day of June 2001.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

These Regulations further amend the Health Service (Medical Appliances) Regulations, 1990, as amended, by allowing infusion sets and accessories for insulin pumps to be prescribed as a medical appliance.
