The Health Service (Pharmaceutical)(Prescribed Appliances)
(Amendment) (Guernsey) Regulations, 1980

THE STATES INSURANCE AUTHORITY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section ten of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical)(Guernsey) Law, 1972, as modified by the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Prescribed Appliances)(Guernsey) Ordinance, 1977 and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders:-

Amendment of regulation seven of the principal regulations

1. Sub-paragraph (1) of regulation seven of the Health Service (Pharmaceutical)(Prescribed Appliances)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1977, as amended (hereafter in these Regulations referred to as "the principal regulations"), is hereby repealed and the following sub-paragraph is hereby substituted therefor -

"(1) Subject to the following provisions of this regulation, a person supplied by an approved appliance supplier with a prescribed appliance to which this Part of the Law applies shall not be liable to pay a prescription charge in respect of that appliance but, instead, shall be liable to pay to that approved appliance supplier a charge (hereafter in these regulations referred to as "an appliance charge") in relation to an appliance set out in column (1) of the Third Schedule to these regulations of such amount set out in respect of such appliance in columns (2), (3) or (4) of that Schedule as is applicable on the date when such appliance is so supplied to that person, unless there is furnished to that approved appliance supplier a declaration in such form as shall be approved by the Authority to the effect that such person is a person in respect of whom a certificate of exception granted by virtue of paragraph (3) of this regulation is for the time being in force."

Amendment of the Third Schedule to the principal regulations

2. The Third Schedule to the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Prescribed Appliances)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1977, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations") is hereby repealed and the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations is hereby substituted therefor.

Citation, collective title and commencement

3. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical)(Prescribed Appliances)(Amendment)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1980.

(2) These regulations, the principal regulations, and the Health Service (Pharmaceutical)(Prescribed Appliances)(Amendment)(No.2)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1979 may be cited together as the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Prescribed Appliances)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1977 to 1980.

(3) These regulations shall come into operation on the first day of September, nineteen hundred and eighty.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport)

These regulations further amend the Health Service (Pharmaceutical) (Prescribed Appliances)(Guernsey) Regulations, 1977, by increasing the charges payable to Approved Suppliers by persons supplied with prescribed appliances.
